My name is NAME, Mother of STUDENT NAME a k-12 student at SCHOOL NAME School; Student ID #. This is my formal request for information, resources, and proper documentation of due process for the following:

1. Due Process establishing a student transportation safety board seated by only parent members and one school official.
2. SCHOOL DISTRICT process to formally bring issues, grievances, or student safety concerns to the school board to create new policy and change.
3. Due process to submit a FOIA request
4. A copy of SCHOOL DISTRICT Student Safety rights
5. A copy of the district's information on file of Indiana code/ legislation of Student Safety Rights

I am following the process I see stated many times throughout SCHOOL DISTRICT current Student Code of Conduct which states "When concerns or grievances arise, the best way to resolve the issue is through communication" and "In these instances, school administration will make every effort to inform parents of said process and will ensure students have the right to non-incrimination."

As seen in Policy 5710 in regards to harassment and grievances, I hope communication and change can be achieved as I will do my best to work with the district to ensure the incident that happened on 8-18-22 can be used as a learning experience to ensure safety for all students in the district. I will provide a copy of the written Police report from 8-22-22 when it's finished being processed so the district, board and administration has the opportunity to read over what happened that day, ask questions, and hopefully think of ways we can work together to come up with a plan of change, protocols and policies together!

My ultimate goal is to work together through this process as it would be a positive example for citizens of the community, students, administration, and the State; But I will be clear in my stance as ALL students transportation safety, parents rights, students rights are "my responsibility as a student parent" [stated by you in policy 5710] in which [I agree.] I will work with the school administration, boards, and any other resources provided by you as long as its civil.

I included Officer Trent Howard in this email for two reasons:

1. He is the officer that I filed the report with on 8/19/22
2. I would like to keep him in communication/ informed while working to make change because he has jurisdiction over the current board as a result of SB0192

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DIGEST OF SB 192 (Updated April 26, 2007 5:50 pm - DI 71)

School safety. Requires a school safety committee to submit a copy of the floor plans for each building located on the school's property to the law enforcement agency and the fire department that have jurisdiction over the school. Requires school corporations to abate certain school building safety violations that are not immediate safety hazards before the earlier of: (1) one year after the state fire marshal's determination; or (2) six months after the start of the school corporation's next budget year. Requires at least one: (1) tornado preparedness drill; and (2) manmade occurrence disaster drill; during each semester of school. Provides that the governing body of a school corporation (including a school city) may establish a school corporation police department staffed by police officers who have general police powers. Provides that the governing body of a school corporation in collaboration with local law enforcement shall establish the powers of the school corporation police officers. Provides that school corporation police officers' survivors are eligible for death benefits. Requires school corporation police officers to have law enforcement academy education and pre-basic and basic training and to participate in local continuing education programs. Requires a school corporation police officer who was appointed before July 1, 2007, to complete the law enforcement academy education and basic training requirements not later than July 1, 2010. Imposes deadlines for school corporation police officers to begin law enforcement academy education and basic training requirements. Provides that a school corporation police department established before July 1, 2007, is considered a school corporation police department established under this legislation.
